And so they'll be seven members who will advise the government ideas and policies to improve experiences well-being and connection and researchers found LGBTIQ+ plus people with disabilities have often encountered unique access barriers within their local communities due to a lack of inclusion and greater challenges and poor outcomes than LGBTIQ+ plus people.

With disability sad as that is to say in terms of mental health harassment and a difficult topic again, 1800 184527 mention of family violence, but of course all people have expertise lived expertise and knowledge professional and lived expertise. So that will benefit everyone and it will give prominence and visibility to intersectional queer community members. It's going to sit alongside the health and well-being and Justice working groups and work closely with the Disability advisory Council to ensure that needs and challenges are met as the previous previous people in lab used to say quality is not negotiable. I'm not sure who is meant by Jan Fran with Anna Media with Percy and the ugly ugly biases there now. I mean, you know, it is totally a stereotype that all Muslims are homophobic because of course they're to start with there are lgbtiq A-Plus Muslims. I mean, that's the simple answer and it's just, you know, this whole attitude where elements of politics elements of media try to wedge queer and religion and simply there. Of course, there are religious quiz, though. So which I'm saying, too

People trying to say that of course, so it's not not accurate at all. And it's it is incredibly sad when we have these comments by people from a minority who then make comments and I'm not sure whether the comments against sending the payment were, you know, sort of Islamophobic homophobic misogynistic, but of course, it doesn't matter and I don't I look I'm honestly unaware of her track record on queer issues.

Choose I have to do that novel concept that 95% of commercial media need to learn about again called research and find out what the go is but you know, I think that and I'll do that during the next track as well as anything else and see what I can come up with quickly.
